



WAB Executive Committee Member Guidelines

(modified and accepted by the EXCO in Dublin, Ireland, July 6th, 2016)

- 1) Requirements and expectations of WAB Executive Committee members are not excessive.
- 2) Most communication will occur via email or other electronic forums. It is expected that all members of the WAB Executive Committee will review the emails and respond to each discussion topic within a reasonable time (7-14 days).
- 3) Attendance at the Executive Committee meetings at each World Buiatrics Congress is very important to the work of the Executive Committee. It is expected that each Executive Committee attend the meetings held in conjunction with the World Buiatrics Congresses.
- 4) Executive Committee members are expected to provide productive and constructive input to the Executive Committee and Officers to further the work and mission of the WAB.
- 5) Members who do not participate in Executive Committee electronic communications and do not regularly attend the Executive Committee meetings held in conjunction with the World Buiatrics Congresses should not expect to be elected to a second four-year term.
- 6) All electronically approved motions will be copied into the agenda of the next face-to-face meeting of the Executive Committee and will be included in the minutes of this meeting.
