1. Annual Conference of Japan Veterinary Medical Association will be held in Gifu, February 11 to 13, 2011 by Japan Veterinary Medical Association, Japanese Societies for

Farm Animal Veterinary Medicine, Small Animal Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Public Health. A special symposium on "Nutrition, immunity, and health of periparturient dairy cows" with a keynote lecture by Prof. Sordillo, Michigan State University is scheduled on February 11, 2011.

2. International Symposium on Declining Fertility in Dairy Cows in the World; Its Causes and Possible Solutions was held in Miyazaki, January 30 to 31, 2010, jointly with Annual Conference of Japan Veterinary Medical Association. Ten papers were presented by invited speakers from Canada, U.S.A., Korea, Japan, Australia, Israel and France. The proceedings of the symposium were published in Journal of Reproduction and Development 56, Supplement S1-S65 (2010).
3. Prof. T. Nakao, a committee member of WAB, has been elected as President of Japanese Society for Farm Animal Veterinary Medicine for a term of 2 years from 2010 to 2011.
