Interesting news from the last world buiatic congress

Outstanding assistance of the delegates from Latin America at the XXVI World Buiatic Congress in Santiago de Chile in 2010 made possible that 50 % of the delegates arrived from South and Central America, highlighting the participation of Chile (253), Brazil (233), Argentina (76), Mexico, (67), Colombia (51) and Uruguay (50).

The rest of the world, Europe participated with 33%, North America with 7%, and East Asia & Pacific with 6%.


